Center School designated “2016 Commendation School” at State House

The Center School was one of 46 Massachusetts schools honored at the State House on February 1st for being named a “2016 Commendation School.” Representative Kate Hogan (D-Stow) joined Ross Mulkerin, Principal of the Center School, at the awards ceremony.

Each year a subset of Level 1 schools are recognized as Commendation Schools for their academic accomplishments. A school can be commended for demonstrating high achievement, high progress, and/or narrowing proficiency gaps. The Center School, an elementary school serving students from the towns of Bolton, Stow, and Lancaster, was commended for “high progress.”

Earlier this month Rep. Hogan, Mitchell Chester, Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education, and Brooke Clenchy, Superintendent of Nashoba Regional School District, toured the Center School to meet with instructional staff and students and highlight the school’s achievement.
