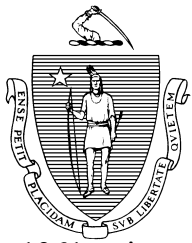
Scouts in the House

The troop went on a tour of the State House and enjoyed cookies and conversation about leadership and public service in Rep. Hogan's office. The girls, in grade 7, quizzed Rep. Hogan about her role as a legislator and shared their own career goals.

9, 1961, prior to his inauguration, which is depicted on a commemorative plaque in the House chamber.

“Courage – integrity – judgment – dedication – these are the historic qualities of the Bay Colony and the Bay State – the qualities which this state has consistently sent to this chamber on Beacon Hill here in Boston and to Capitol Hill back in Washington,” Kennedy stated.
