### **Rep. Hogan talks civic engagement with Stow Girl Scouts**



State Representative Kate Hogan visited with Stow Girl Scout Troops 88058 and 62466 during a recent troop meeting at the Randall Library. Rep. Hogan answered questions about her duties as a legislator and provided an overview of the various bills she is working to pass through the Massachusetts House of Representatives this session. The group then read aloud “Grace for President,” a children’s book about a young girl who, upon learning that the U.S. has never had a female president, launches her own candidacy for class president. The book sparked further conversation about the importance of being civically engaged; Rep. Hogan hopes she managed to convince a few Scouts to run for office themselves one day!
