Rep. Kate Hogan named to special “Trump” working group

(BOSTON) – Representative Kate Hogan (D-Stow) is one of nine Democrats in the Massachusetts House of Representatives just appointed by Speaker Robert DeLeo to a working group charged with evaluating legislative and other actions taken by the Trump administration that have the potential to negatively impact Massachusetts residents. The group is expected to develop proposed solutions designed to mitigate the impact of those changes. Initially, the group will focus on federal changes that impact economic stability, health care access, women’s health, higher education, the environment, and the state’s most vulnerable residents.

“I am honored to have been appointed to, and to have the opportunity to serve on, this working group,” said Representative Kate Hogan. “These are uncertain times. Far reaching changes are being proposed to federal policies and programs—many of which have benefited the Commonwealth and its people for decades—sometimes with little or no formal evaluation of the impact which these changes will have. I think it is only prudent that we at the state level stand ready to assess and respond, where necessary, to safeguard the interests of the Commonwealth and its people.”

Remarking on Speaker DeLeo’s willingness to address this matter, Representative Hogan noted that she “very much appreciated Speaker DeLeo’s formation of the working group as a vehicle for getting a handle on the proposed changes coming out of Washington. It puts us in a much better place to identify, understand and navigate the issues and challenges that await us down the road. This is an important time for those of us in Massachusetts to fight—and fight hard—to protect the values and traditions we hold dear and the interests of this state and its people. As always, I will work in the best interest of my constituents, this great Commonwealth, and our beloved country as we move forward.”

In addition to her role in the working group, Representative Hogan is the House Chair on the Joint Committee on Public Health. She also serves as Chair of the Elder Caucus and Library Legislative Caucus.
